MS. MILLER: The qualifications for the
 Certified Florida Appraiser and Certified Florida
 Evaluator professional designations include at

least two years of experience with a Florida property appraiser's or tax collector's office or the Florida Department of Revenue, at least 120 hours of approved education, and current employment with a Florida county property appraiser's or tax collector's office or the Florida Department of Revenue. The Certified Florida Appraiser designation is reserved for the county official.

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9 The qualifications for the Certified 10 Cadastralist of Florida include at least two years 11 of experience with a Florida property appraiser's 12 office or the Florida Department of Revenue, at 13 least 150 hours of approved education, and current 14 employment with a Florida property appraiser's 15 office or the Florida Department of Revenue.
